Starting up

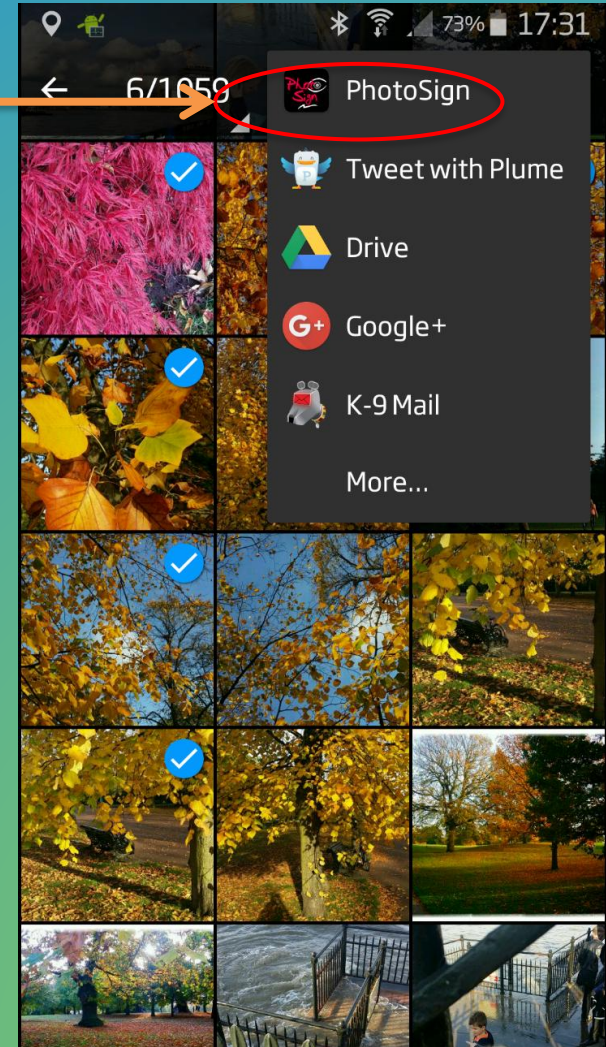
Install PhotoSign from Google Play

Two options:

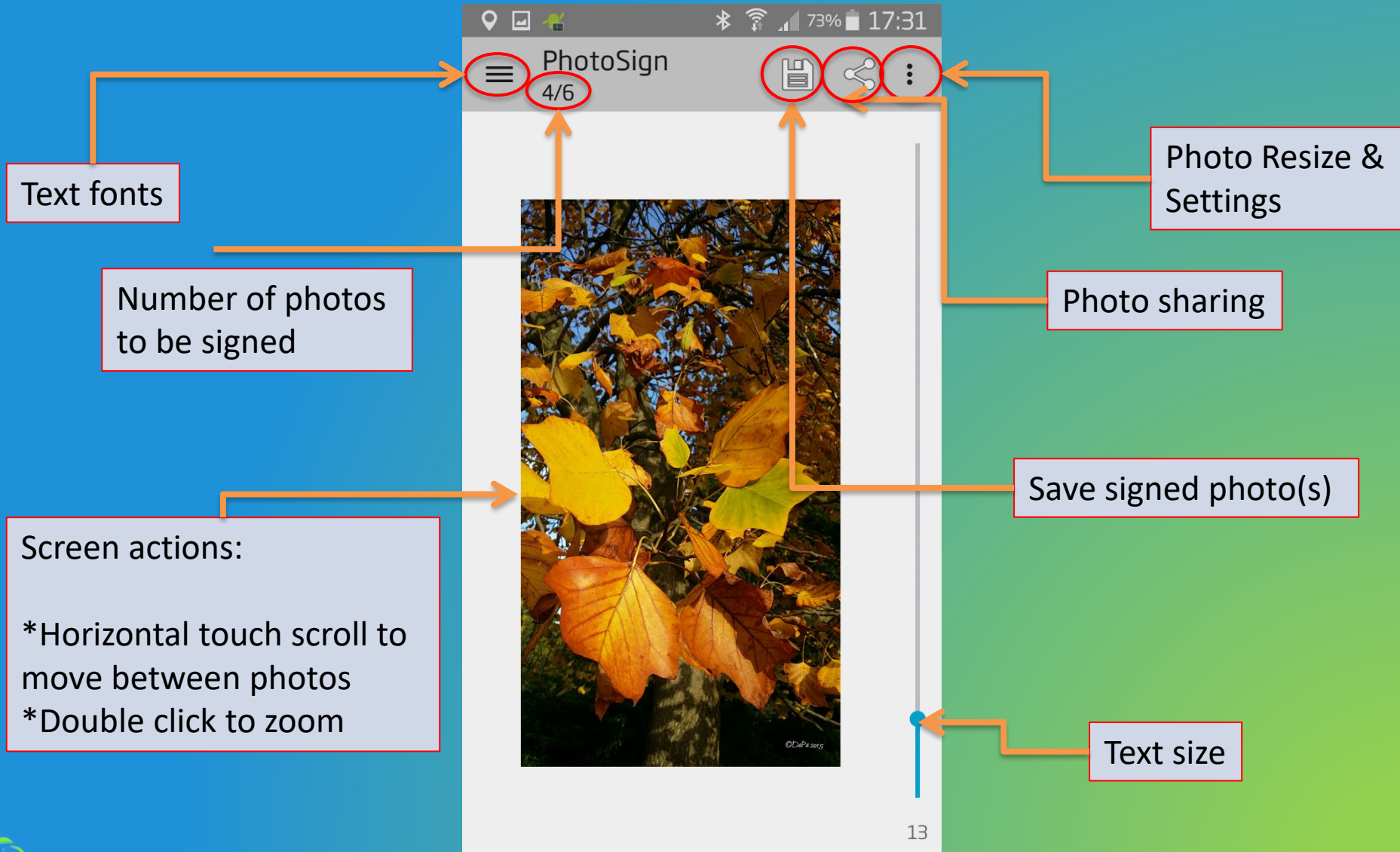
- Use ad-based free PhotoSign:

- **IMPORTANT:** PhotoSign does not show up as an individual app; it can only be accessed from an image viewing app through the Android sharing option!

Start PhotoSign

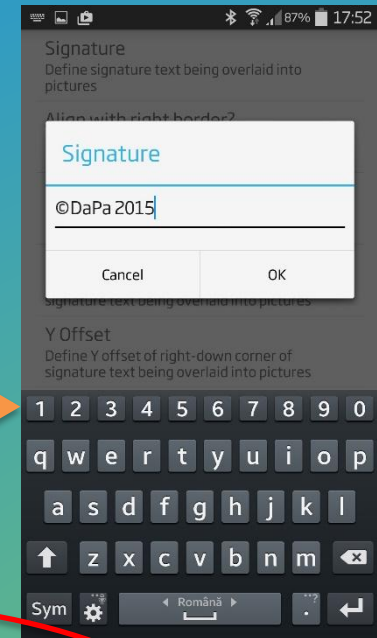
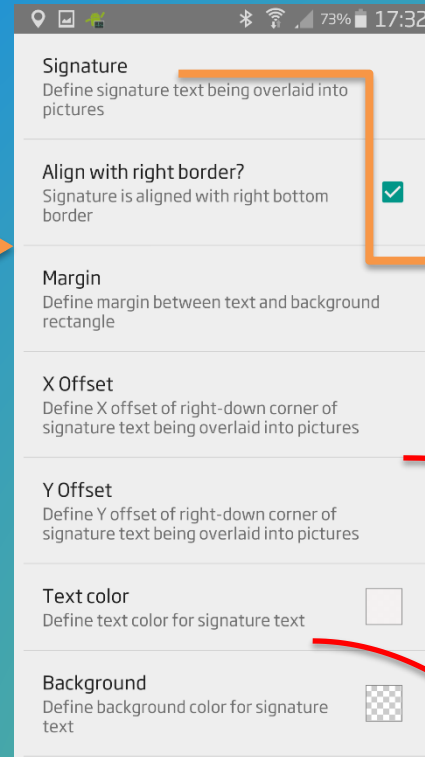
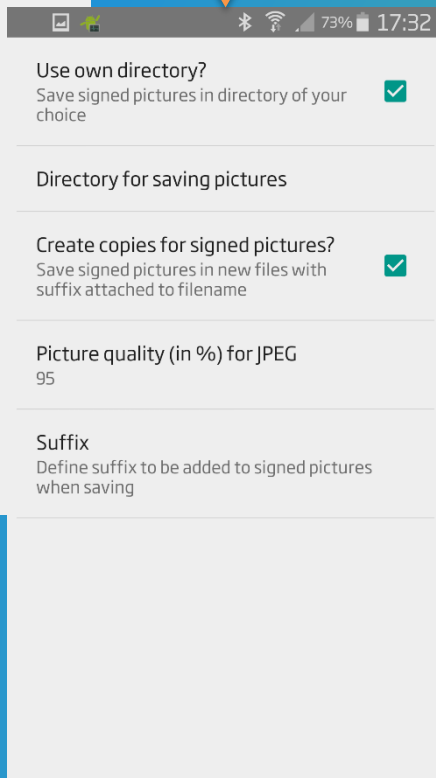
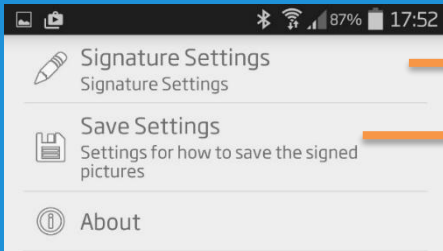
- Go to your preferred gallery app
- Select one or more photos to be signed
- Go to Android sharing menu
- Select PhotoSign from the list of apps

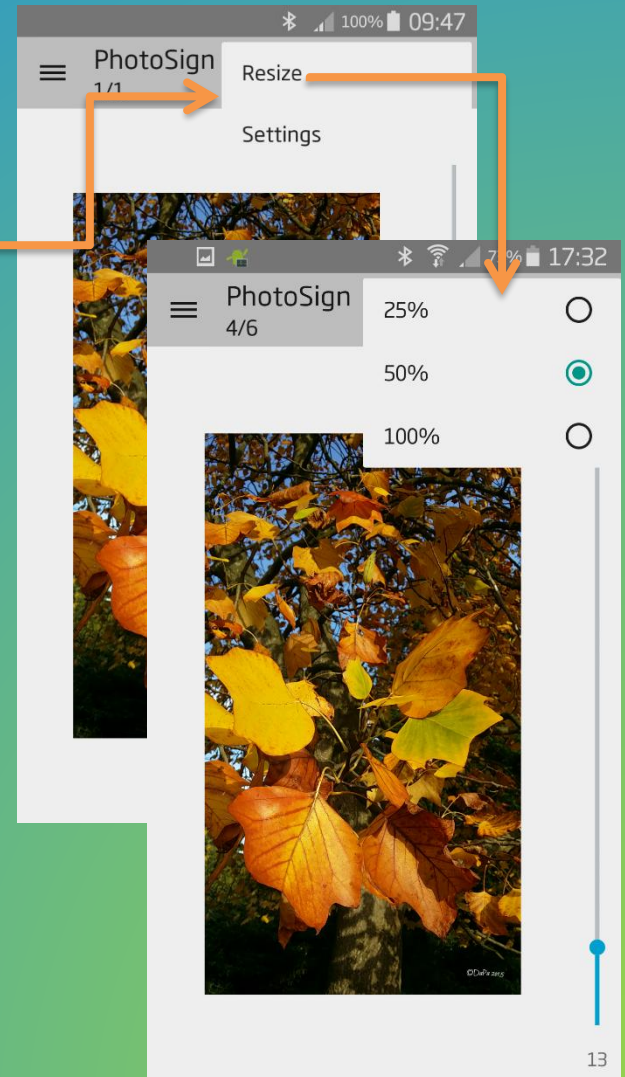
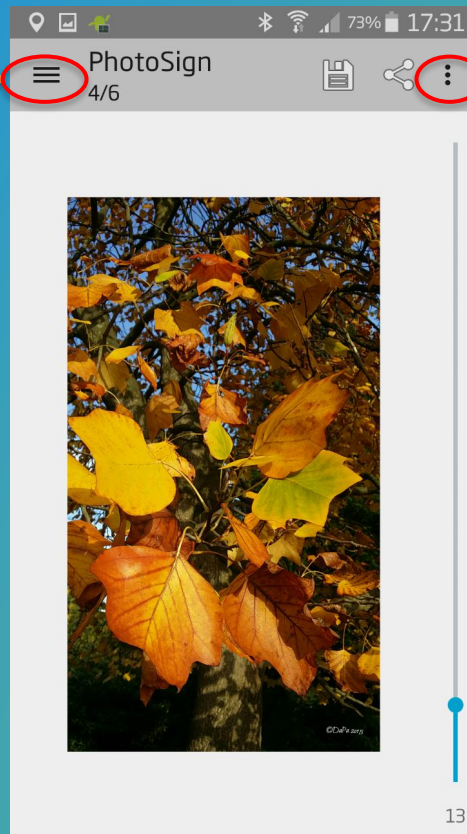
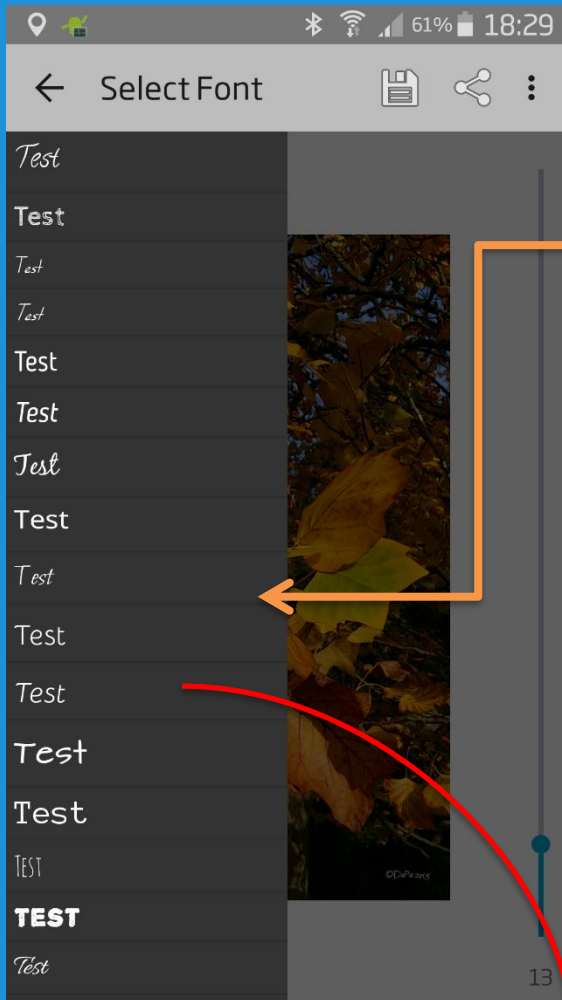


Set text position relative to right down corner

More settings

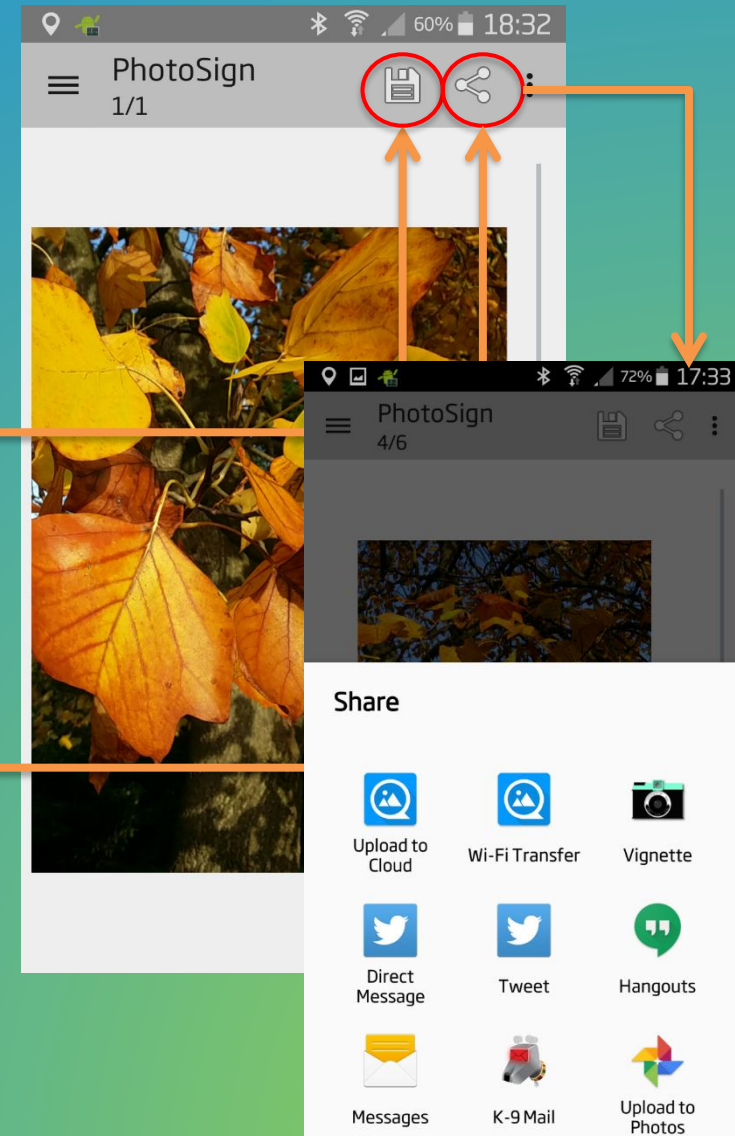
Set photo size before saving
